Child and Adult Care Food Program

Our Purpose is to insure that children in child care settings receive nutritious, well-balanced meals. We aim to improve the diet of children ages birth to twelve years of age, by providing training and reimbursing child care providers for the nutritious meals and snacks they serve. The Child and Adult Care Food Program is administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Education on behalf of the United States Department of Agriculture.

Meal Requirements

Breakfast

- milk
- juice, fruit or vegetable
- bread or bread alternate (cereal or other food from enriched flour)

Lunch

- milk
- one meat or meat alternate (poultry, fish, cheese, eggs, dried beans and peas, peanut butter)
- two fruits and/or vegetables
- bread or bread alternate (roll, pasta or rice)

Snack

- two choices from the four components: milk, meat / meat alternate, fruits / vegetables, bread / bread alternate



In the operation of the Child and Adult Care Food Program, no person will be discriminated against because of race, color, national origin, sex, age or handicap.
